COLTS and LCTA to Begin Selling Inter-County Bus Passes Wednesday

Scranton, Pa.—The County of Lackawanna Transit System and Luzerne County Transportation Authority announced today the launch of the Inter-County 31-Day Bus Pass on Wednesday, March 1. The pass, available for \$60, will allow passengers unlimited access to all routes on both bus systems.

The pass can be purchased at the Lackawanna Transit Center, COLTS headquarters on North South Road, online at coltsbus.com, the LCTA Intermodal Center, LCTA Administrative Offices in Kingston, and online at lctabus.com.
