COLTS Announces LCTA Route 17 Bus to Have Bus Stop at LTC

Scranton, Pa. – The County of Lackawanna Transit System and Luzerne County Transportation Authority announced today that LCTA’s Route 17 bus now has a stop at the Lackawanna Transit Center. The bus stop is in the cutout area on Lackawanna Avenue in front of the LTC and will have a bus stop sign.

“COLTS and LCTA made this decision because we want to make our systems as customer-friendly as possible,” said Bob Fiume, COLTS Executive Director. “In the coming months, we will be looking at ways to improve upon our routes to make COLTS more efficient. We will also be looking at better connections between COLTS and LCTA, and a new COLTS route into Wilkes-Barre.”

“We are very pleased with our working relationship with COLTS. In working together we are able to improve services for all of our customers,” said Norm Gavlick, LCTA Executive Director.
