COLTS Monthly Pass To Be \$60, Become Intercounty Pass

COLTS to accept all LCTA passes effective July 1

Scranton, Pa. – The County of Lackawanna Transit System (COLTS) will change the cost of its monthly pass to \$60 effective July 1. The current \$56 monthly pass, which is royal blue, will be sold for \$60 after July 1 and will be usable on both COLTS and Luzerne County’s transit system.

“All of fares and passes will officially be in line come July 1,” said Bob Fiume, Executive Director. “COLTS and LCTA have been working together and decided to be pro-active to encourage travel between our two counties. The single monthly pass will allow passengers to transition smoothly between the two bus systems.”

The white passes that say “Intercounty Pass” in red lettering will also continue to be accepted. The blue passes with orange lettering will be sold to the public until that inventory is gone.

In addition to the \$60 Intercounty Pass, COLTS will accept ALL LCTA passes. LCTA has already been accepting COLTS passes. COLTS does sell a 31-day adult student pass that LCTA does not sell, but will still accept.
