COLTS to “Stuff the Bus” for Toys for Tots on Wednesday

Scranton, Pa. – The County of Lackawanna Transit System (COLTS) will hold its Seventh Annual “Stuff the Bus” toy drive to benefit the Marine Corps Toys for Tots Foundation on Wednesday, Dec. 7, from 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. at the Lackawanna Transit Center, 30 Lackawanna Ave. People can drop off new, unwrapped toys and books at the Lackawanna Transit Center, where “Holly the Trolley” will be parked. Monetary donations will also be accepted. Marines and COLTS staff will also collect donations on the Spruce Street side of Courthouse Square from 11:30 a.m. to 1 p.m.

This year, COLTS has teamed up with Rock 107 for the toy drive. Rock 107’s Prospector will be live from 7 a.m. until 10 a.m. and the radio will broadcast all day until 6 p.m.

“We are really hoping the community comes out and supports this toy drive. It would be nice to have a trolley filled with toys for area children,” said Executive Director Bob Fiume. “Based on the success we have had in the past years, we are hoping to bring joy to girls and boys who otherwise might not have had presents to open.”
