COLTS Expanding Service Beginning Monday, July 6

Lackawanna Transit Center to Reopen July 1

Scranton, Pa. – The County of Lackawanna Transit System (COLTS) will expand its Fixed Route service with a return to modified Saturday schedules on Monday, July 6. All Fixed Route buses will run Saturday schedules with modifications and exceptions. The Saturday schedules will be in effect Monday through Saturday and until further notice. Demand Response Service will no longer be available as of July 6.

COLTS will reopen the Lackawanna Transit Center and reinstate collection of fares and passes on Wednesday, July 1. COLTS will be closed on Friday, July 3 in observance of the Fourth of July holiday. COLTS is also closed on July 4.

“We are pleased to be able to expand our service again. COLTS remains committed to keeping our passengers and employees safe, and we will continue to take all necessary precautions to do so,” said Executive Director Bob Fiume. “For example, we continue diligent cleaning and sanitization of our vehicles daily.”

COLTS continues to recommend the use of face masks or coverings when riding buses or vans.

The #13 Drinker/Marywood, #21 East Mountain/Oakmont, #25 Valley View/Hilltop, #54 Green Ridge/Dickson City, and #46 Mall Circulator are running their regular Saturday routes with no modifications at this time. The #82 Simpson/Carbondale/Route 6, #83 Newton/Ransom, and #84 Chinchilla/Clarks Green/Justus are permanently cancelled, with senior hi-rises on those former routes now served by COLTS’ Shared Ride. Routes with additions and modifications are listed on the next page, and the routes with major schedules modifications are listed at the end of this press release.

Exceptions and Modifications:

-The **#12 Jessup** *will* continue to go to Comprehensive Treatment Centers during the week. Both inbound and outbound trips pick up there at :40 past the hour. On Saturdays, it will only stop at CTC at 8:40 a.m. outbound and 9:40 a.m. inbound.

-The **#18 Petersburg** *weekday* adds a 6:20 a.m. outbound and 6:50 a.m. inbound.

-The **#26 Mohegan Sun WILL run during the week. Outbound:** 9:15 a.m., 11 a.m., 2:35 p.m. // **Inbound:** 10 a.m.; 11:45 a.m.; 3:20 p.m.

-The #26 on Saturdays: **Outbound:** 9:15 a.m., 10:35 a.m., 2:35 p.m. // **Inbound:** 10 a.m.; 11:20 a.m.; 3:20 p.m.

-The **#28 Pittston** adds a 6:15 a.m. outbound and 7:15 a.m. inbound Monday through Friday.

-The **#31 Old Forge / Stauffer** adds a 6:15 a.m. outbound and 7 a.m. inbound Monday through Friday; these trips service Stauffer Industrial and not Price Chopper. The other Outbound trips that service Stauffer Industrial Park (and not Price Chopper) Monday through Saturday are 7:15 a.m., 8:15 a.m., and 2:15 p.m., and the Inbound trips that service Stauffer (and not Price Chopper) are 8 a.m., 3 p.m., and 5 p.m.

-The **#34 Keyser Valley** adds trips to the schedule on Monday through Friday: **Outbound:** 7:15 a.m., 8:15 a.m. // **Inbound:** 6:40 a.m., 7:40 a.m., 8:40 a.m.

-The **#37 Lafayette / Oram** *will* service Geisinger Mt. Pleasant on Monday through Friday. The outbound pickup time for Geisinger is :20 past the hour. The inbound pickup time at Geisinger is :10 past the hour.

-**#43 Viewmont/Bangor** and **#45 Viewmont Express:** If a trip is outbound as a #43 Viewmont/Bangor, it is inbound as a #45 Viewmont Express. If a trip is outbound as a #45 Viewmont Express, it travels inbound as a #43 Viewmont/Bangor.

-The **#52 Carbondale** adds one *inbound* trip Monday through Friday at 7 a.m.

-The **#71 Evening City Circle North** and **#72 Evening City Circle South** are running their weekday schedules Monday through Friday and their Saturday schedule on Saturdays.

The following routes have major schedule modifications: **#41 High Works, #48 Dalton / Waverly, #99 Minooka / Montage.** Please see attached schedule for specific information on these three routes.
