COLTS To Reinstate Fares

Scranton, Pa. – The County of Lackawanna Transit System (COLTS) will reinstate fare collection beginning Wednesday, July 1, 2020.

Both Fixed Route bus service and Shared Ride van service will collect fares and passes again.

Fares were waived beginning April 25 as a way to keep a safe distance between drivers and passengers at the beginning of the COVID-19 pandemic.

COLTS encourages passengers to wear masks or facial coverings that protect a person's mouth and nose.

Until further notice, buses will continue to run on the current level of service: 10 fixed route buses and Demand Response service provided by COLTS' Shared Ride vans. The routes include #12 Jessup, #18 Petersburg, #28 Pittston, #31 Old Forge, #34 Keyser Valley, #41 High Works, #43 Viewmont/Bangor, #52 Carbondale, #71 Evening City Circle North, and #72 Evening City Circle South.

The Lackawanna Transit Center will remain closed until further notice.
